

CRSA 4v4 Futsal Friendlies

Tournament Rules

1. Game Duration

- A game will consist of one 25 minute period.
- No half-time, no time outs.
- Play will begin and end simultaneously on all fields. Players should be on the fields and ready for play 2 minutes before time begins.

2. Number of Players

- Each team will consist of no more than six (6) players. Four players are allowed on the field at a time. There is no designated goal keeper.
- Double rostering is not allowed.
- Substitutions may be made on the fly. Incoming player must wait for exiting player to exit field.

3. Player Registration

- All players must be registered on the team roster before being allowed to play.
- Team manager must present signed waiver/roster form at check-in. No waiver, no play.
- Please present player cards at check-in.

4. Goal Scoring

- A goal may be scored any time after the ball has passed the half field line.
- If a player shoots the ball prior to the half way line, and the ball enters the goal, the goal will not count.
- If a player shoots the ball prior to the half way line, and the ball hits an opposing player, and then enters the goal, the goal will not count.
- No direct goals will be awarded from out of bound plays or free kicks.
- All balls played from out of bounds or from free kicks must be touched by an in-play player before a goal may be scored.

5. No Goal Box in play

6. Out of Play

- No throw in. All out of play balls must be kicked in at line of exit.
- No direct goals will be awarded. The ball must be kicked in and touched by one other player, offensive or defensive, before a goal will be awarded.
- A ball hitting any structure outside the playing area, ie: ceiling, lights, beams, is deemed out of play.
- For u9-u12 teams ONLY-all defending players must drop back past mid-field when the ball is played in as a goal kick.

7. No off-sides

8. Fouls

- Referees will award free kicks after the calling of a foul.
- Goals may not be scored on a direct kick. All goals off free kicks must be indirect.

9. Penalty Kicks

- Penalties shall be awarded at the discretion of the referee.
- Penalty kicks shall be taken at the halfway line with all players behind the halfway line.
- The team that incurred the penalty will get possession of the ball in the form of a goal kick after the penalty kick has been taken if a goal does not occur.

10. Yellow Cards

- A player may receive a yellow card for foul language, tackling, rough play, or an intentional handball.
- The ball will be played from the spot of the foul with a free kick. No direct goals allowed.
- A player receiving 2 yellow cards in one match will automatically be issued a red card and must leave the game immediately. The player will also be suspended for the next game.

11. Red Cards

- A player can receive a red card for multiple yellow cards, tackling from behind, retaliation, or fighting.
- A player receiving a red card shall leave the playing field immediately and will be suspended for the next game. The team of the red carded player is not allowed to replace them with another player. They will play one man down for the duration of the game.

12. No Sliding or slide tackles.

13. Uniforms

- All players must wear the same color shirts while competing.
- All players must wear shin guards
- All players must wear indoor soccer shoes or tennis shoes. NO CLEATS!
